SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS FOR ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATIONS

The deadline for abstract submission is **February 1st, 2019**. Submissions received after this deadline will not be considered. All abstracts have to be submitted by using the default template to office@emca-online.eu. You have to download the **template form**, fill in all the required fields and submit it to office@emca-online.eu as attached file (**name the document with your last name**).

Abstract guidelines

All abstracts for oral and poster presentations must be submitted (and will be presented) in English using UK English spelling with accurate grammar and spelling suitable for publication. The abstract length may not exceed **300 words**. Do not send supplementary material (photos, articles or reports) with your abstract. All abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The authors are asked to assign the abstracts to one of the following topics:

The primary/submitting author will receive an email message confirming the receipt of the abstract and he must inform the co-authors. The primary/submitting author will receive a confirmation of acceptance for oral presentation, poster presentation, or rejection, by e-mail before January 15, 2019. All accepted abstracts will be published in the abstract book.

Withdrawal policy: If authors will withdraw their abstracts from presentation or publication they are requested to send a letter via e-mail to the conference secretariat before January 15, 2019. Consequently, the abstract will not be printed.

General format:

- ❖ The abstract length **may not exceed 300 words**. Please do not include tables, charts, or other figures in the abstract content.
- ❖ **Title:** Maximum **200 characters** including spaces, typed in lower-case letters, except for abbreviations, the first letter of title, pronouns and study names. Abstract titles should be brief, clearly indicating the nature of your presentation.

- ❖ **Session:** Select one topic from the list above. The presentation will be assigned to one of the appropriate session.
- ❖ **Category:** You must select one of the following categories under which your abstract will be classified:
 - oral presentation
 - poster presentation
- ❖ There is no character limit for your authors or author affiliations.
- ❖ Please note that the first (presenting) author should be underlined and marked with an asterix. If there is only one affiliation, do not use numbering. The names of authors will be published as listed.
- ❖ Please ensure your abstract and submission details are correct. It will be printed exactly as it appears in the abstract submission system.

Posters

Posters must fit within the confines of a 100 cm high x 70 cm wide poster board and consist of materials that can be mounted easily.

The poster session is scheduled for 12 March from 18:00 - 19:30. The posters will be on display during the whole conference.

Student Poster Competition

EMCA will award a cash prize to three undergraduate or graduate students or those who have graduated in 2018. A written confirmation is required by the Head of the University Institution.

Important Procedural Information

- ❖ Concomitant with the submission of an abstract both, registration and payment of the fee are required.
- ❖ The oral presentations may not exceed 12 minutes with three additional minutes allowed for questions.
